The Risbury Show has been a fixture in our community's calendar for many years. It is an opportunity to see the best which our talented residents of all ages can do in the garden, cookery and crafts, and to compete for the coveted prizes, section cups and rosettes!

Everyone across our parishes is welcome to submit entries, and we hope that whether entering or not, you will come to join in the traditional end-of-summer celebration.

Rules

1. Entries must be submitted **between 9.30 and 11.30am** on the day.
2. An entrant can enter up to **TWO** entries in **each** class.
3. Each entrant will be given an anonymous entrant number, to be placed on each entry.
4. **Containers:** please supply your own vases/plates.
5. **Judging:** Judges will award 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each class (at their discretion if they find several equally good entries, they could award them all 1st). Cards will be displayed to show prizes: RED for 1st, YELLOW for 2nd and BLUE for 3rd.
6. **Points** are awarded for prizes (1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point). In each section the entrant with the most points will be awarded the **Section Cup**.
7. **Red rosettes** will be awarded to outstanding entries.
8. **Best in Show:** The shield will be awarded to the individual entry from any class judged to be the Best in Show.
9. **Childrens' Prizes:** Small money prizes will be given in the Junior Classes.
